Summary of Experience

Hamish is currently based in RSHP's office in Paris.

From 2015 – 19, he was project lead on the Louvre Conservation Center in Liévin - a facility designed to integrate storage and conservation of more than 250,000 works of art that are currently distributed between 60 different locations around France.

Hamish also played a key role in the elaboration of the Bercy Charenton masterplan in Paris and participated in the Atelier International of the Grand Paris study, examining the changing needs of metropolitan Paris in the 21st Century. On these schemes he gained experience of urban design and worked as part of a complex international, multidisciplinary team.

Hamish led the services coordination on the new T1 Terminal of the St-Exupéry Airport in Lyon through all phases of the project, including being based in Lyon as a site architect. On site, Hamish represented RSHP in contractor and client meetings, acting as concept guardian for the design. He monitored architectural compliance on site and ensured communication with the project team in London.
