Summary of Experience

Mimi is an integral part of the RSHP team, having worked in our London, New York (2006-2008) and Sydney (2010-2015) offices since joining the practice in 2001.

As project architect and team lead for 2 Redman Place at The International Quarter (IQL), a new business quarter in Stratford, London, Mimi led the delivery of the 35,000m² Grade A office building, alongside the design and detailed coordination of the facade package. Focussing on the core values of health and wellbeing in the workplace, this building is currently occupied by Cancer Research UK and the British Council and was certified BREEAM Outstanding (with a score of 94%) and WELL Gold.

As a member of the leadership team in the Sydney office, Mimi was responsible for delivering the Concept Plan Amendment for the Barangaroo South masterplan. Following approval, and the appointment of RSHP to design and deliver three commercial towers (International Towers Sydney), Mimi's focus moved to the design of the facades for the three towers and podia, leading coordination, with the specialist subcontractor, and delivery.

In New York, Mimi worked on the construction documentation phase for Tower 3 at the World Trade Center and the concept and scheme design phases for the refurbishment and expansion of the Jacob Javits Convention Center.

Mimi has been involved in a number of other diverse projects. These include the Barangaroo and Sydney Metro competitions and a masterplan for Victoria Harbour, Melbourne. She has worked on several residential developments in New York, Monte Carlo, and the UK; educational and civic buildings, including Mossbourne Community Academy in London, and the Senedd Cymru, Welsh Parliament in Cardiff. Mimi was responsible for delivering a series of new suites and external terraces at The Berkeley Hotel in London and is currently working on an international city-scale masterplan.
