## Summary of Experience

Daniel initially joined the practice in 1996, and after completing his post-graduate studies, returned in 2000. He was made an Associate in 2004 and Associate Partner in 2016.

He has been involved in a range of projects - including airports, residential, offices and public buildings - and at all stages, from competition, feasibility to post-contract. He was the site representative on both Paddington Waterside, London and The National Assembly for Wales, Cardiff and has worked on a number of projects at earlier stages, including these residential projects: NEO Bankside and Riverlight in London; and The Port Authority Bus Terminal Tower in New York.

Daniel worked on The Leadenhall Building in the City of London between 2006 and 2014 during the project's development, including the scheme design phase, and again during the tender and construction phases of the project. He was responsible for the cladding and steel structure of the building's north core.

Daniel was also responsible for the steel and concrete structural frame on Lyon-St Exupéry Airport from scheme design stage through to completion. More recently, he has been providing technical design assistance for the INNO modular housing projects and has been involved in a number of competition bids. He is currently project architect for the 20 Carlton House Terrace project.

Daniel has been a member of the RSHP Recruitment Team since 2001 and mentors junior staff members. He has also taught post-graduate students at the Bartlett School of Architecture, UCL where he has been a practice tutor and crit juror for the 4th year Design Realisation module. He is currently a guest crit juror for Unit 14. He is also a Trustee of The Art Academy, an independent art school in London.
