Summary of Experience

Andrew was made a Partner in 2016 and has been involved in a number of key projects as an architect and masterplanner. His work has included design and masterplanning, presenting schemes to clients and working on transportation and airport infrastructure projects as well as giving strategic advice on commercial developments for developer clients.

Andrew is currently leading Bao An Terminal 4 in Shenzhen, China and Taoyaun Airport T3 and he was the project lead on the 7 million square foot Wood Wharf Masterplan in London gaining planning permission for one of the largest undeveloped sites in East London.
