Summary of Experience

Alleen joined Rogers Stirk Harbour + Partners in 2007, was made an Associate in 2014 and a Senior Associate in 2016.

Alleen started work at the practice as part of the NEO Bankside team, developing the award-wining residential scheme adjacent to the Tate Modern in London. She was primarily focused on the internal fit-out for the apartments, and later involved in developing an office building and a single storey pavilion within the Bankside development. NEO Bankside was shortlisted for the RIBA Stirling Prize in 2015.

More recently, Alleen was one of the architects on Burlington Gate seeing the project through to its completion in 2017. Burlington Gate is a mixed used gallery and residential development with the first new public arcade since the 1930s in London's Mayfair Conversation Area.

In addition to Alleen's on-site experience gained from both Burlington Gate and NEO Bankside, she has also worked on a wide range of projects in the early stages, including residential, office and infrastructure schemes.
