Summary of Experience

Throughout his career, Harjinder has successfully led the design and delivery of a number of commercial and mixed-use masterplanning projects, working alongside a diverse array of local planning authorities and communities.

From 2018, Harjinder led the design and delivery of No. 2 Redman Place, a 35, 000 sqm Grade-A office building in Stratford, London, having successfully achieved a BREEAM 'Outstanding' rating. In the early stages of the project, Harjinder led the development of the envelope and facade packages, coordinating with specialist sub-contractors and representing the team at client meetings, as well as monitoring progress on site through the construction phase. The building completed in August 2019.

Harjinder also played a pivotal role on 30 Bay Street in Toronto, a 300m tall commercial office tower in the heart of the central district of the city. Harjinder was integral to the team developing the facade package during the tender phase in coordination with the executive architect.

Harjinder has recently been leading the delivery of Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Youth Entrepreneurship Zone, a 140,000 sqm mixed-used masterplan in Shenzhen, which includes connecting a cultural urban centre to a transportation hub. Harjinder's role as project architect has involved liaising with our local team in Shenzhen, developing the design of the individual buildings and coordinating the design intent with the local design institute. Phase 1 of the masterplan is nearing completion, with Phase 2 due for completion in September 2022.

Harjinder is currently based in RSHP's London studio and is project lead for a 21,000 sqm student accommodation building in Hammersmith, London.
